MOTORCYCLE CLASSES

Street: = **MA** Motorcycle of any brand or design, typically without saddlebags or windshield

Cruiser: = **MB** Motorcycle of any brand or design with saddlebags and windshield

Touring: = **MC** Motorcycle of any brand or design typically with fixed fairings and hard saddlebags

Sport: = **MD** Motorcycles of any brand or design typically look like track racing motorcycle

Custom: = **ME** Motorcycle typically custom or modified frame and engine with custom paint, wheels, seat, etc.

American Classic: = **MF** Motorcycle must be 20 or more years old

Foreign Classic: = **MG** Motorcycle must be 20 or more years old

OTHER AWARDS: Best of Show and Sponsor's Choice

There will be a first and second place winner in each category.

No vehicle may be entered in more than one category. Three or more visible modifications to engine, frame and/or body will place vehicle in custom division.

The judges decision is final—entries close at 10:00AM.

Completion of an entry form indicates acceptance of conditions of the show.
